The Hawai‘i Primary Care Office (PCO) is a program in the Hawai‘i Department of Health. The goal of the PCO is to improve access to primary health care for medically underserved populations. Funding is primarily through the federal Bureau of Health Professions and in-kind contributions by the Hawai‘i State Department of Health.

Hawai‘i Primary Care Office Projects:

- **Federal Shortage Designations**—The PCO applies to the federal Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) for federal designations of medical underservice and health professional shortages in specific geographic areas of the state. Medically Underserved Areas (MUA) and Medically Underserved Populations (MUP) designations are required for federal Community Health Center funding. Health professional shortage areas (HPSA) designations for primary care, dental, and mental health are required for recruitment of National Health Service Corps scholarship recipients or loan repayment personnel. The PCO is also responsible for updates of all HPSAs which must be completed every three years. A table of *Status of Federal Designations and Assistance* is included in this directory. - **Recruitment and Retention**—The National Health Service Corps (NHSC) works with the PCO as its state partner for the placement of health personnel in HPSAs. Primary care sites located in HPSAs are eligible for recruitment of NHSC scholars and loan repayment personnel. All site applications for NHSC assistance are sent (through the PCO) to the NHSC.
- **Primary Care Needs Assessment Data**—The collection and dissemination of data related to primary care needs statewide is done through the PCO publication, *Primary Care Needs Assessment Databook*. In this publication, health and socioeconomic data are displayed and compared for 28 communities statewide. A risk scoring of these communities is also provided. These data are used in policy decisions and targeting of scarce resources.
- **Primary Care Contracts for Uninsured**—The Hawai‘i Department of Health Family Health Services Division (FHSD) administers state-funded primary care contracts for uninsured visits at Community Health Centers and other primary care sites statewide. The PCO provides input to the contracting process and the administration of these contracts.
- **Community Development**—The PCO provides technical assistance to communities that are interested in improving access to primary care. Usually a local committee or consortium is established to work toward the goal of 100% access to care and zero disparities for everyone. Outcomes may be improved networking and referral among existing providers or the development of a Community Health Center.

.....**State District Health Offices**

The State District Health Offices serve their communities with proficiencies in emergency preparedness, family health services, public health nursing, services for the developmentally delayed, environmental health services which include vector control, clean air, clean water, and sanitation programs, vital statistics (births, marriages, deaths), and mental health services.
