JOB OVERVIEW: Within the scope of licensing as an RN and APRN, the Nurse Practitioner (NP) will provide general medical care, assessments, evaluation, treatment and some minor surgery for patients.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- ❖ Provides direct and/or indirect patient care oriented toward improving or maintaining health and preventing illness.
- ❖ Performs physical examinations and/or preventive health measures to assess and evaluate patient's clinical problems and health care needs.
- ❖ Refers patients to other available services to meet needs where appropriate.
- ❖ Maintains and updates patient charts, records and information.
- ❖ Coordinates and refers services of community resources and/or other community partners with families, clients, or patients receiving services.
- ❖ Communicates with others regarding patient status and progress to provide education, guidance, case management and follow-up.
- ❖ Ensure patient confidentiality and HIPAA regulations are followed.
- ❖ Be able to employ cultural and linguistic approaches necessary to communicate effectively with patients.
- ❖ Ensures compliance with Lana`i Community Health Center policy and procedures as outlined in the Lana`i Community Health Center Employee Handbook.
- ❖ Keeps informed of and complies with all occupational safety guidelines. Takes all reasonable precautions to prevent accidental injury on the job.
- ❖ Participates in staff meetings and conferences and attends all training sessions as assigned.
- ❖ Carries out other related duties as required and assigned by the Medical Director and/or Executive Director.
